Appropriate Interpersonal Boundaries Two Adult Rule First Aid/CPR Training Annual Orientation for Workers 5 years older rule No workers under 18 Windows in all classrooms Open Door Counseling Limited Counseling Advance notice to parents Participant Covenant for all participants and leaders Parent and Family Education Appropriate Equipment and Supervision Adequate Insurance for the Scope of your ministries Youth Group websites Transportation Rules/Guidelines

Not only should a congregation focus on the safety of their children, but also on the safety issues that are unique to youth and youth ministries.
