

## Neighbor Center Applications

## <u>Transformational/Redevelopment Examples</u>

- <u>Developing Children's Ministry</u> A church is considering the potential of a daycare ministry. Using Neighbor Center you can <u>identify the households with children</u> that have Head of Households between the ages of 25 to 34 and 35 to 44 years old.
- <u>Developing a Youth Ministry</u> A church is developing a new youth ministry. Using Neighbor Center you can identity the <u>households</u> with children in a <u>selected</u> age range. For example select children ages 6 to 10, 11 to 15 or 16 to 17 depending upon the focus of a new youth ministry program.
- Engaging Existing Congregational Strengths A church has a strong
  presence of Mosaic D15 households in their congregation. Using Neighbor
  Center you can identify other Mosaic D15 households in the area for
  potential outreach to families with similar characteristics to the current church
  membership.
- Expanding Older Adults Ministry A church has a very active retired ministry. Using Neighbor Center you can identify other households in the community with similar characteristics by selecting corresponding Head of Household ages 65 to 74 or 75+ or specific Mosaic households representing active retired lifestyles.



- <u>Expanding Ministry With Low Income Families</u> A church has been providing ministry to a group of
  households with young children with financial challenges and would like to expand this ministry. Using Neighbor
  Center you can locate other households with children and low household income facing similar challenges.
- <u>Reaching New Movers</u> A church wants to welcome New Movers into the community. Using Neighbor Center
  you can locate families that have moved into the area within the last 6 months. <u>Combining Neighbor Center
  and People Plot</u> you can view your Members in relationship to New Mover households on the map.

## **Church Planting/New Mission Examples**

- Raising an Initial Core Group After determining the Mosaic Household Type/s most likely to be engaged by a new mission, Neighbor Center allows you to view selected Mosaic Households on the map. The resulting households could be (1) invited to an initial mission gathering at a (2) strategic meeting location nearest to the concentration of selected Mosaic Household types.
- <u>Expanding the "Reach" of a New Church Plant</u> Using Neighbor Center in conjunction with People Plot you
  can view the existing core group members in relationship with new movers or with other demographic
  selects with similar characteristics.
- <u>Establishing a Mission to Targeted Groups</u> Using Neighbor Center you can select variables such as <u>Single Marital Status</u>, <u>Age Range</u>, <u>Gender and Mosaic Household Type</u> to locate the households that are included in a particular vision for a targeted ministry.

Note: The design of Neighbor Center allows for the selection of multiple demographic variables in order to create a highly focused list of households with characteristics that match a particular ministry emphasis.

- ✓ Selecting **New Movers AND a specific Mosaic Household Type/s** will result in a different group of households than by simply selecting New Movers.
- ✓ Selecting Households with Children, Primary Gender/Female and Marital Status/Single will provide Single Female Households with Children a growing segment of the population.
