Rev. Dr. Martin Stanley Beason

Rev. Dr. Martin Stanley Beason, 81, of Broken Arrow, Okla., died March 25, 2014.

Stan was born Feb. 11, 1933, to S.E. and Ethel P. Beason. He earned the Master of Art at the University of Alabama, Master of Journalism at American University of Washington, and Doctorate of Theology from Emory University.

He began his ministry in 1964 in the North Alabama Conference and was ordained in 1967. He moved to Oklahoma in 1981 to direct the Prayer Partner Program at the City of Faith medical center in Tulsa.

In 1989 he began Oklahoma Conference service. He was pastoral counselor at Tulsa-First UMC and then pastored at Marietta from 1996 until officially retiring in 1998.

He was an avid craftsman.

Rev. Francis Leon Harrel, 86, of Broken Arrow, Okla., died April 7, 2014.
